



# CONTAGIOUS RESPIRATORY ILLNESS ASSESSMENT GUIDELINE FOR SOCIAL ISOLATION

March 16, 2020

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA	YES	NO
A) Fever (have a measured temperature of 100.4 °F [38 °C] or greater; or feel warm to the touch; or give a history of feeling feverish) accompanied by one or more of the following:		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. skin rash</li><li>2. difficulty breathing or suspected or confirmed pneumonia</li><li>3. persistent cough or cough with bloody sputum</li><li>4. decreased consciousness or confusion of recent onset</li><li>5. new unexplained bruising or bleeding (without previous injury)</li><li>6. persistent vomiting (other than sea sickness)</li><li>7. headache with stiff neck</li></ol>		
B) Fever that has persisted for more than 48 hours		
C) Acute gastroenteritis, which means either:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. diarrhea, defined as three or more episodes of loose stools in a 24-hour period or what is above normal for the individual, or</li><li>2. vomiting accompanied by one or more of the following: one or more episodes of loose stools in a 24-hour period, abdominal cramps, headache, muscle aches, or fever (temperature of 100.4 °F [38 °C] or greater)</li></ol>		
D) In the last 14 days, did you: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Have close contact with a lab-confirmed COVID-19 patient?</li><li>2. Travel from affected geographic areas subject to <i>Widespread sustained (ongoing) spread</i> per <a href="http://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers">www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers</a></li><li>3. Have close contact with a person who has travelled from affected geographic areas subject to <i>Widespread sustained (ongoing) spread</i> per <a href="http://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers">www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers</a></li></ol>		

Note: 'close contact' is defined as less than 6 ft
