March 18, 2020

The safety and health of GLDD employees, subcontractors, visitors and customers is our top priority. As the coronavirus outbreak continues to spread, GLDD is monitoring the situation closely on a daily basis and implementing risk mitigation actions as needed, to protect the health, safety and general welfare of GLDD employees, subcontractors, visitors and customers.

In an effort to further screen personnel entering GLDD facilities and vessels, we ask that you complete the following short questionnaire. Your honest answers will assist us in protecting the health, safety and general welfare of all personnel.

Additionally, all personnel entering GLDD facilities and vessels are subject to further screening and body temperature checks upon arrival and throughout the time you are present.

<p>A) Fever (have a measured temperature of 100.4 °F [38 °C] or greater; or feel warm to the touch; or give a history of feeling feverish) accompanied by one or more of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. skin rash 2. difficulty breathing or suspected or confirmed pneumonia 3. persistent cough or cough with bloody sputum 4. decreased consciousness or confusion of recent onset 5. new unexplained bruising or bleeding (without previous injury) 6. persistent vomiting (other than sea sickness) 7. headache with stiff neck 		
B) Fever that has persisted for more than 48 hours		
<p>C) Acute gastroenteritis, which means either:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. diarrhea, defined as three or more episodes of loose stools in a 24-hour period or what is above normal for the individual, or 2. vomiting accompanied by one or more of the following: one or more episodes of loose stools in a 24-hour period, abdominal cramps, headache, muscle aches, or fever (temperature of 100.4 °F [38 °C] or greater) 		
<p>D) In the last 14 days, did you:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have close contact with a lab-confirmed COVID-19 patient? 2. Travel from affected geographic areas subject to <i>Widespread sustained (ongoing) spread</i> per www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers 3. Have close contact with a person who has travelled from affected geographic areas subject to <i>Widespread sustained (ongoing) spread</i> per www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers
